2. Nahid Khalil, Itedal Abdulraheem & Rashida Abdulrahim. (2019) by The Impact of E-Learning vs Traditional Learning on Student's Performance and Attitude. In this research paper the Main Objective of the Study was to understand the Impact of online Learning on the student's academic Performance. Study was conducted among 80 nursing students at Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The Conclusion from the Study was that it showed a significant difference in learning outcomes beside positive attitudes between the Online and Traditional Learners which can be considered as one of the alternative methods to teach for Higher Education in education sector.
3. Salamat, P & Ahmad, L & Bakht, G & Saifi, Imran. (2018). EFFECTS OF E-LEARNING ON STUDENTS' ACADEMIC LEARNING AT UNIVERSITY LEVEL conducted a Detailed study on the Effects of E-Learning on Students at the University Level. The main Objective of the Study was to find the Effects and Interest of Learning using such online Platforms. 4. M. Samir Abou El-Seoud, Islam A.T.F. Taj-Eddin, Naglaa Seddiek, El-Khouly, M. M., & Nosseir, A. (2014). E-Learning and Students' Motivation: A Research Study on the Effect of E-Learning on Higher Education which was conducted in Egypt. They concluded that the teachers should find whether they were motivated with Online learning class but it was difficult to analyzing it as there was lack of Personal Contact in the Online Classes and to avoid it an assessment is to be done about Motivation. Using the Data obtained from that feedback Form will help to understand whether students were motivated. 5. Saleem, M., & Rasheed, I. (2014). It was a Descriptive Study and done through a Survey collected from 100 Students of Islamia University Students at Bahawalpur. Data Analysis:




Interpretation 2.1:


Interpretation 2.2:




Table 2.4: Do you think E-Learning makes it easier for you to attend your Sessions?









FINDINGS
