2. The clubs are putting more efforts in building and maintaining their main team after the introduction of professional cricket in the state.
3. Since the introduction of state cricket league, entry of outsider players to Manipur cricket has increases many folds.
4. The players are working hard to maintain their position in the team because competition among players has increased after the introduction of state cricket league in the Manipur.
5. The standard of cricket in the country has improved after the introduction of the state cricket league.
6. People involved with cricket are in favor of professional cricket and they are quite confident that it is professional cricket that is going to improve the standard of cricket in the Manipur

7. There is a great demand of outside coaches by Manipur players. Most of the respondents are not in favour of outsider coaches to train their team.
8. No long term coaching programme is carried out by the state cricket associations

Recommendation

In the light of the conclusions drawn the following recommendation are made:-

1. The All Manipur cricket Association and the professional clubs should set up a full professional structure of cricket to run the professional cricket in the Manipur at the earliest.
2. The cricket calendar of Manipur cricket should be prepared in advance before the beginning of the season and there should not be any change during the season.
3. The format of the All Manipur cricket Association should be fixed at state cricket league, for the convenience and success of clubs and cricket in the Manipur.

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
